Participants were taught strategies for dealing with disagreements and conflicts constructively. Encouraging healthy debates and showing flexibility were highlighted.



### **Personal Connections:**



The speaker addressed common interview-related stress and nervousness. Techniques to manage anxiety and stay composed during the interview were discussed.



### **Objectives:**


