Participants were taught strategies for dealing with disagreements and conflicts constructively. Encouraging healthy debates and showing flexibility were highlighted.


Interactive Session:

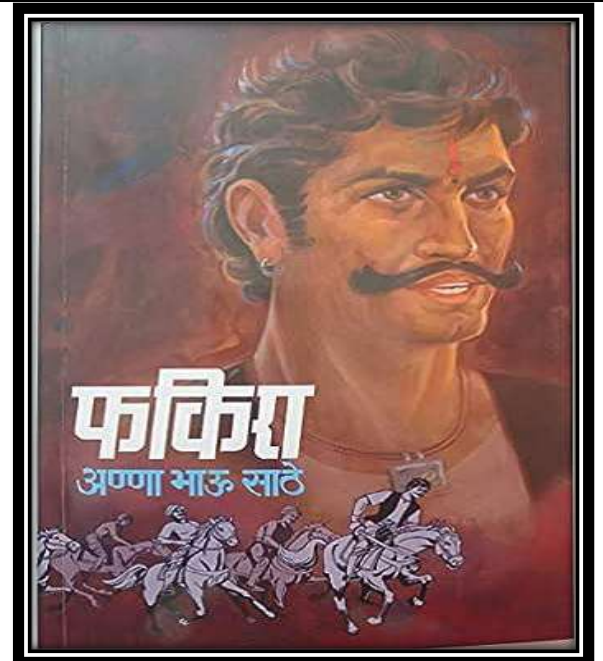

Objectives:

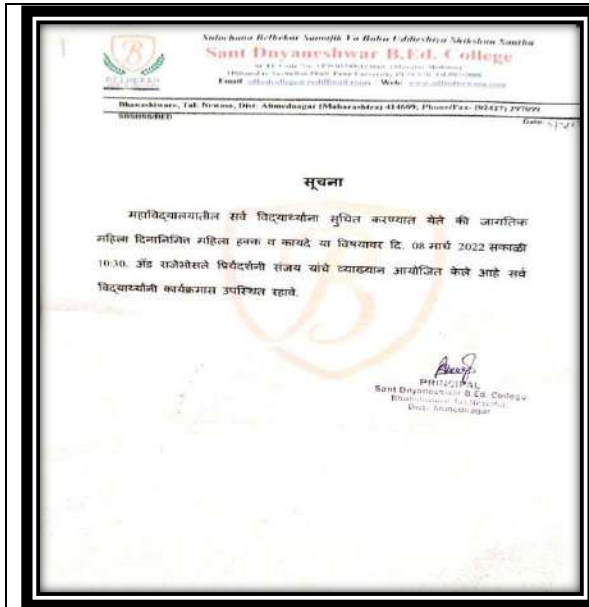

Key Highlights of the Lecture: During the lecture, various aspects of NEP-2020 are discussed including:

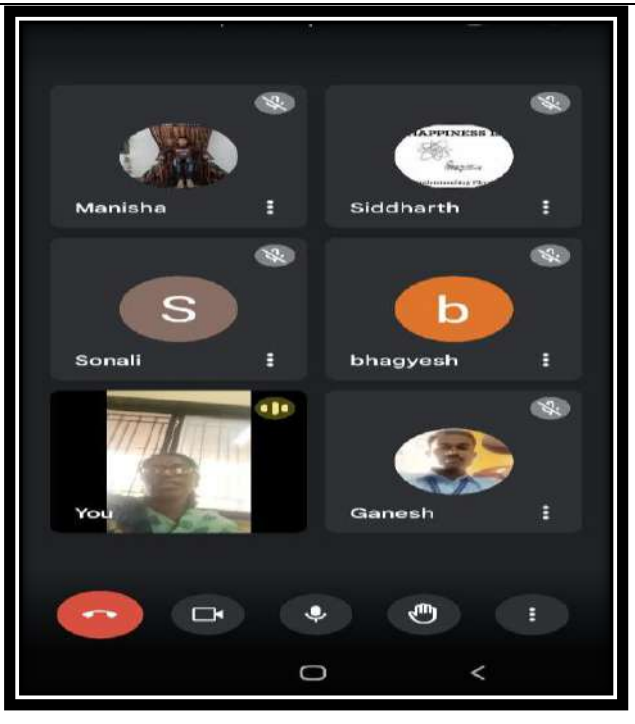

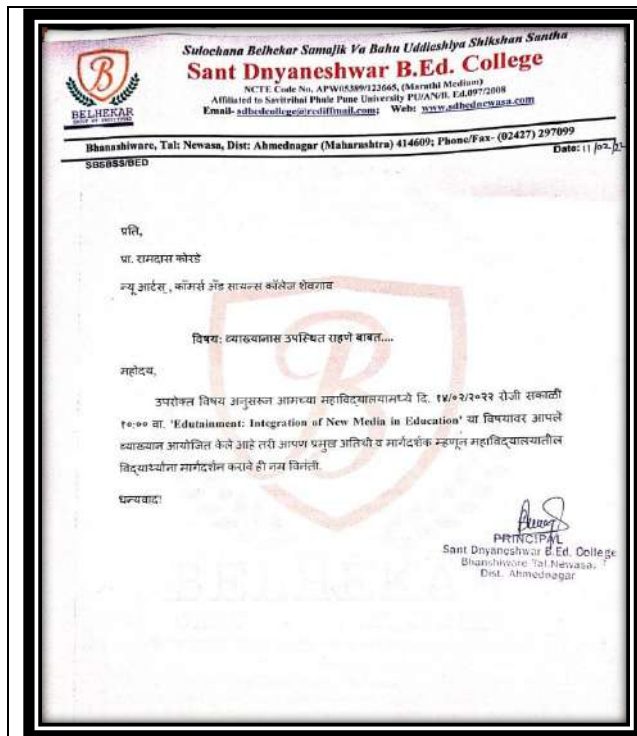

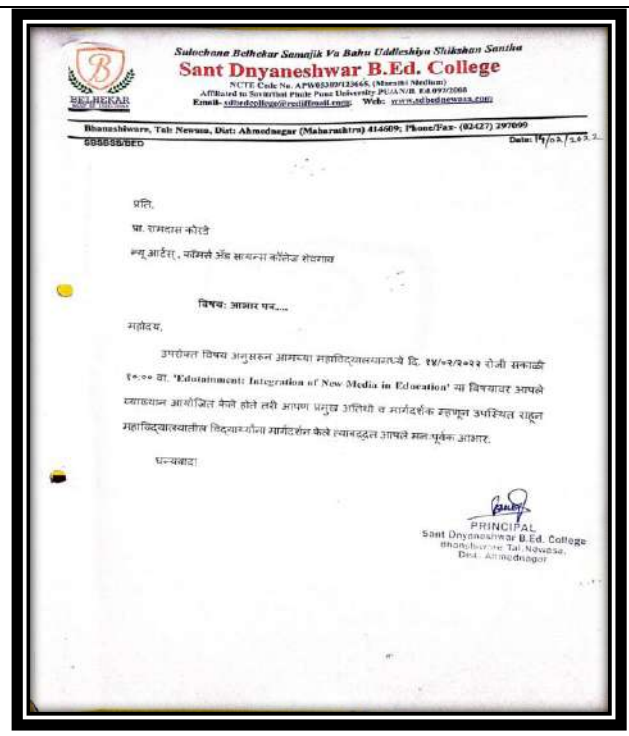
Key Highlights of the Lecture:
